# **Andale Images Quick Start**

Printable Instructions:

### **Uploading an Image**

- 1. Sign in to www.andale.com
- 2. Click on the 'Auction Tools' tab. Then click on the **Images** link beneath.
- 3. Click **Upload Images**, in the row of links directly underneath the tabs.
- 4. Uploading an image is basically copying an image from your computer, and storing it at Andale.com so that you can use in for an eBay ad or other web page.

### **Upload Images Page**

- 1. Click the gray **Browse** button to look for your images in your computer.
- 2. In the pop up that appears, click on the icons, or use the dropdown menu, to point it to where the images are stored in your computer.
- 3. Select the Image you want to upload.
- 4. Click the next Browse button to upload another image.
- 5. Browse and select all the images you want to upload.
  - If using a 56k modem, start with less than 10 images at once.
- 6. On the right hand side, you can click on the drop down arrow to select a folder of your choice to where the image(s) should be uploaded.
- 7. Click the **Upload** button at the bottom right corner of the page.
- 8. After images upload you will see the Image Library with a thumbnail size version of your image. All of your images are stored in your Image Library.
  - Check the File Size column to see how large your images are.
  - See the Learn More at the top of the page for more about image size.

### Adding an Image to a Live Ad

- 1. If your images are not uploaded to Andale yet.
- 2. Sign in to www.andale.com
- 3. Click on the 'Auction Tools' tab. Then click on the **Images** link beneath.
- 4. Click the gray **Browse** button across from the Select Image field.
- 5. Select the image from your computer.
- 6. Enter the eBay Item Number in the next field.
- 7. Click Attach Image.

## Image Library Page

- 1. First, you must have already uploaded your images. See directions above.
- 2. **Select the image(s)** you want to attach by clicking the checkbox(es) to the left.

- 3. Click the **Attach Images to Ad** button at the bottom right of the page.
- 4. You can chose whether you want them to be added as:
  - a) Thumbnails with click to enlarge images
  - b) Full-size images or
  - c) Photo Album
- 5. Enter the eBay item number
- 6. Click on Continue and complete the process to upload the image(s) to the eBay item number.

### **Attach Images Page**

- 1. Choose the preferred layout. Use the Learn More to get explanations of options.
- 2. In the Attach to Ad section, click the yellow Choose Item button.
- 3. In the pop up that displays your current Live Ads, select the ad you want to attach the image to by clicking the checkbox to the left.
- 4. **Scroll** to the bottom of the page and click the **Add** button.
- 5. The images you selected will be attached to the ad you selected.

### Adding an Image to the Sell Your Item Form at eBay

- 1. Upload your images to Andale.com as above.
- 2. Click the **Images** tab, then **Image Library** underneath.
- 3. Copy the URL for the image from the Image Library. (The URL is located beneath each image name)
  - eBay pre-fills the first http:// part of the URL in the image section of their form.
  - When you copy and past the URL, be sure not to end up with "http:// http://URL..."
  - Either delete the http:// in the eBay field, or don't copy that part of the URL from Andale.
- 4. Paste the URL into the Sell Your Item Form at eBay.

#### Adding Images to a web page or other web form

- 1. Upload your images to Andale.com as above.
- 2. As above, copy the URL from the Image Library and paste it in between the HTML "Tags".
  - Paste the whole thing into your web page, or form, wherever you want the image to appear.
  - Publish, or preview, if you want to make sure you got it right, and to see exactly where it is showing up.
